We have designed an individual programme specifically for the older students which will involve free time relaxing in the swimming pool, sports/dance/fitness, technology, drama and movie making, creative art projects and experimental science.

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Confident swimmers will also be able to take part in a Lifesaving Course. All activities will be carried out in a fun, relaxed, creative manner and the students will be given a free choice of the activities that they take part in. There will even be an opportunity for the students to suggest the activities that they would like to do. The focus of this programme is for the students to have fun and social time with each other whilst being in a safe, educational environment where they will have the opportunity to learn new skills, hang out with their friends, be stimulated and stay active during the hot summer. **In addition, this year we have planned a greater variety of sporting and 'free-time' activities to keep everyone busy and entertained.**

Location

We will be based at the beautiful Senior School premises in Latsia. A bus service from the Junior School to and from the Senior School will be offered every day, or alternatively you may drop your child off at the Senior School. The bus will be leaving from the Junior School at 7.30am and will return at 2.45pm (leaving the Senior School at 2.15pm) Please complete the relevant section on the application form if you will require your child to use this bus service. **Please note that in order to use the bus service, it must be used for the entire week, both to and from the Senior School. It is not offered for one journey or for individual days. A seat on the bus must be reserved by filing in the application form before the deadline. Students will not be able to use the bus service unless a seat has been reserved. Please see the application form for bus prices.**

If you choose to take your child directly to the Senior School, the children can be dropped off from 7.30 am at the main entrance to the athletic centre. It is essential that when you drop your child off in the morning (at either school) that they are registered with the member of staff who will be there to welcome them. Pick up will be at 2.30pm at the main entrance of the athletic centre. You will also need to sign your child out before leaving for the day with the teacher on duty.

Breakfast and Lunch

A buffet style breakfast and lunch is provided free of charge by the school canteen. Fruit salad is also served at break time.

Students will eat their breakfast at 9.30am and lunch at 12.30pm. In addition to this, snacks and drinks will be sold in the tuck shop.

Trip to MacKenzie Beach

Students will need to wear their swimming costumes under their clothes and have a change of clothes in their bag. We recommend they wear flip flops on beach days but may want to keep a pair of trainers in their bag in case they take part in a sport activity later in the day. If your child would like an ice cream while at the beach please give them €2.

Swimming

The Year 7 & 8 students will be able to relax in the outside pool at specific times throughout the day. There will also be water polo offered and life-saving. Students should bring their swimming costume, a towel, flip flops and goggles in a bag, along with sun protection cream.

Early Pick Up

If you wish to pick your child up early from Summer School, they will be eating lunch from 12.30pm until 1.15pm. Due to our free choice option, before and after this time the children could be in various locations around the site. Therefore if you require your child before 2.15pm, please call Esther Alexandrides on 99 354 503 and we will bring your child to you at the main reception of the school.

We will inform you week by week of special events, talent shows, details of trips, visitors etc.
