The children will have the opportunity to participate in a variety of activities during the week: e.g. visit our **brand new** computer suite, use the iPads, visit our library, music time, bubble making, art and baking.

Please note that some activities start at 8.00am.

P.E.

Everyday children will participate in a P.E. lesson, children should wear comfortable clothes and suitable footwear to move around in. Children need to wear a sun hat for P.E.

Master Kids:

Every **Monday Reception children** will participate in a **Master Kids** Science session. Each week the children will be engaged in an exciting and mesmerising Science activity.

Little Kickers:

Every **Tuesday**, all children will participate in a Little Kickers session.

Children should wear a t-shirt, shorts and trainers on this day. Children need to wear a sun hat for this session.

Drop-Off and Pick-Up:

On the first day of the week, we will let you know which room your child will begin and end the day, you will leave your child in this room and will pick your child up from this room. Throughout the day the children will be taking part in a variety of activities which will take place inside and outside their designated classroom. If we need to gather the children in one classroom, it will be the first classroom that is nearest to the gate of the Pre Reception area PRC.

Meals:

Children will be having breakfast/snack at 8.30-9.00am and lunch at 12.00 noon. A healthy breakfast and lunch will be available at school every day and this is included in the price. The children will choose on the day what they would like to eat.

Please pack a fruit for your child for fruit time. At some point during the day, children will have time to eat the fruit they have bought from home.

Please make sure that your child brings a small rucksack to Summer School and that they have two bottles of water labelled with their name and fruit for fruit time. Also remember to send your child with sun cream already applied and a hat. Please complete the sun cream permission form, as our staff will be applying sun cream to your child when we go outside.

Week 1 (2nd – 6th July) and Week 3 (16th – 20th July)

Thursday: Splash Day

There will be water games and children are encouraged to bring in their water guns/equipment to use. We would like all children to wear their swimming costume underneath their clothes and please ensure that they also have a towel, underwear and flip flops in their bag. If possible label all items of clothing.

It is also useful to have a plastic bag inside their bag where the wet swimming costume can be placed.

WEEK 3 ONLY (16th – 20th July)

Friday: Bike/scooter day

Please bring your child/ren's bike or scooter and their safety helmet to school and leave it outside their classroom. If possible please label the safety helmet.

Please ensure that your child has a safety helmet, no child will be able to ride their bike if they do not have a safety helmet.

If your child does not have a bike or scooter, your child will be offered a bike from school or will be offered another activity to do.

Week 2 (9th – 13th July) and Week 4 (23rd – 27th July):

Thursday: Trip to The Senior School

Pre- Reception children

- ❖ There will be a small shallow pool and children are encouraged to bring in their water guns/equipment to use to play water games. Please label any equipment with your child's name. We would like all children to wear their swimming costume underneath their clothes, please ensure that they also have a towel, underwear and flip flops in their bag. If possible please label all items of clothing. ***It is also useful to have a plastic bag inside their bag where the wet swimming costume can be placed.***

Reception children

- ❖ Children will be given the opportunity to swim in the outside pool at the Senior School. There will be a qualified life guard and P.E. teachers, who are experienced in teaching children to swim. If your child would like to swim, please state this on the 'Permission Slip For Trips', which is included with the application form. Children should come to school wearing their swimming costume under their clothes, please include underwear, a towel and flip flops in their bag. ***It is also useful to have a plastic bag inside their bag where the wet swimming costume can be placed.***
- ❖ The children who are in the water, are grouped according to their swimming ability and non-swimmers are not taken out of their depth. Those who lack confidence in the water are given the choice to learn/play in the shallow pool.
- ❖ ***If your child does not want to swim in the outside pool, they will join the Pre-Reception children for water games with their water guns and equipment.***
- ❖ ***Pre-School children will not be attending trips.***

Please print out the application form with permission for attendance to attend trips and sun cream permission. Then submit them with payment to the Finance Department by the latest Monday 18th June 2018.

Please remember that we will only have 32 places for Pre-School children each week and 100 places for Pre-Reception and Reception children each week.
